

**Green Impact Zone
Data Committee
Meeting Summary
October 28, 2009**

- Baseline Study Phase I Status
 - The survey of housing conditions is about half complete
 - The historic survey is almost complete
 - A meeting on the environmental assessment will be held next week
 - Dean will be sending a confidentiality agreement to KCPL and will share with MGE and Water Services. UMKC CEI will also have to sign this agreement.
 - Steve Marsh of Jackson County reports that he should have the 1940's aerials next week, but the 1980s and 90s will take longer
- Dean presented a draft outline for the baseline report and suggestions were made for some changes, especially presenting neighborhood profiles. A revised outline is attached.
 - It was also agreed that we would prepare a preliminary set of data from the work before the end of the year and share this with the neighborhood leadership to get their feedback and begin to discuss conclusions. The full report would be available in February.
- We have a brief report on the KU social survey
 - KU will have a draft survey available by Nov 6 and this will be sent to the members prior to the next meeting
 - This will serve as the basis for a test survey to be used at the Dec 5 Green Impact Zone event
 - This will allow the zone to collect valuable information on community perceptions while providing a test for the instrument
 - We still have to figure out the best way to administer this at the Dec 5 event
 - A question was raised about the need for satisfaction surveys as a baseline for things like electrical service. We agreed to see if this kind of question could be included on the survey.
- The rest of the meeting was used for UMKC CEI to demonstrate the online data access portal they are creating
 - The portal will be GIS based and as simple as possible to use to make it accessible to the community
 - We will want to preview the portal with the neighborhood leadership once it is up and running and has current data
 - We also had some discussion about what data to make public to what audiences
